

COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR THIS TRIAL.

Please keep 6 foot distance from other exhibitors, bring sanitizer, wipes, mask for when you are in close proximity to others. Please bring your own lunch, beverage and water.

SUNDAY – JUNE 7TH – HERDING TESTS

There are 30 Dogs entered at this event and 30 entries.

8:00 A.M. – see note below

PRE-TRIAL TESTS - (7 Dogs) Armband #35 thru 40, 42

9:00 A.M. – see note below

HERDING TESTS - (7 Dogs) Armband #22 thru 28

10:00 A.M. – **see note below**

HERDING TESTS – (6 Dogs) Armband #29 thru 34

11:00 A.M. – see note below

INSTINCT TESTS - (10 Dogs) Armband #43 thru 52

Note – specific times for groups of tests. Parking will be along the road. Check in will be at the gates of the driveway. Only those in the group for that time slot will be allowed to enter. Once your test is complete you will be informed of Pass/Fail/Qualifying at end of the test and ribbons and scoresheets will be available at that time. Entrant is then expected to leave so that we can keep number of people waiting around together to a small number.

All runs will be honored once checked in.

There will be a club representative at the driveway entrance to assist everyone.

Please be prepared with shade cloths, easy-ups, rain gear, sun screen etc.....weather can vary throughout the day.

A bath/cool off tub will be provided if needed.

We are excited to announce that Erin Schaefer will be offering massage at our June 7 herding tests. She is a graduate of the Rocky Mountain School of Animal Acupressure and Massage. The massages will be offered for the dogs entered in the trial and other dogs from a household of a competitor. Your run time will be honored and accommodated.

To ensure the safety of everyone she will be sanitizing between each dog and changing the towels the dogs lay on. It will take place on the east side of the house under the trees, isolated from most of the activity. If your dog needs to have you nearby to feel comfortable for the massage, we ask you wear a mask.

There will be a limited number of massages available for each group since we are trying to keep a timeline between class groups. You can sign up for a time within your group by emailing Erin at agilityaussies1@gmail.com if the time slots don't fill you will be able to sign up the day of the tests.

The massages will be \$25 for a 15 minute introductory massage. You can pay preferably with PayPal, cash or check.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

Hachita Farms

4500 Private Rd 162, Elizabeth, CO 80107

(2nd house on the left, white w/ black trim)

Parking in South pasture. Entry through gate Southwest of the house. Exercise area for dogs will be on leash in this pasture. Please clean up after your dog.

From Castle Rock:

Take Hwy 86 through Franktown and through the town of Elizabeth. At the top of the hill--turn left/north on County Rd 21. Go north on CR 21 for 5.7 miles to Private Rd 162. Turn left/west on PR 162 (dirt road).

From Castle Pines:

Take Hess Rd east --will turn into Hilltop ~1 mile after crossing Parker Road-- stay on for another 4-5 miles to Singing Hills (can only turn left/east). Stay on Singing Hills east for approx. 7 miles (past 2 four-way stops) to County Rd 21 (First right after the second four-way stop). Can only turn right/south at CR 21. Go 1 mile south to Private Rd 162. Turn right/west on PR 162 (dirt road).

From Parker:

Parker Road/Hwy 83 to Hess Rd. Left/east on Hess Rd—will turn into Hilltop after about a mile--stay on for another 4-5 miles to Singing Hills (can only turn left/east again). Stay on Singing Hills east for approx. 7 miles (past 2 four- way stops) to County Rd 21 (First right after the second four-way stop). Right/south at CR 21. Go 1 mile south to Private Rd 162. Turn right/west on PR 162 (dirt road).

From Colorado Springs:

(I-25) North to Castle Rock (Wilcox exit) North to Hwy 86. East on 86 through Franktown to Elizabeth. Continue through Elizabeth--look for County Rd 21 at the top of the hill on your way out of Elizabeth. Left (North) on CR 21 for 5.7 miles to Private Rd 162. Left (west) on Private Rd 162 (dirt road). You can also come up from the Springs on Hwy 83 to Franktown, then turn right (west) on Hwy 86 to Elizabeth and continue. More scenic and usually less traffic.

Please note this Trial site does **NOT** have spaces for RVs and overnight camping is not allowed.
